**Learning Accommodations that can be supported at Marian:**

- Academic Monitoring Sheet
- Preferential Seating
- A peer note taker/teacher's notes
- Simplify directions
- Record lessons
- Laptops at the teacher's discretion
- Computer printed assignments
- Time lines for long-term projects
- Visual and auditory directions
- Alternate location to take the exam
- Other test accommodations

**Learning Accommodations that cannot be supported at Marian:**

- Curriculum Modification
- Modified Assessments
- ESL Instruction

**Process for Requesting Accommodations:**

- All requests for learning accommodations will be considered after Marian has reviewed the following:
  1. Previous academic performance and testing
  2. Teacher reports on current academic performance.
  3. A student's diagnosis from a qualified professional.
- Incoming freshmen who are requesting accommodations should submit their documentation by July 1 of the coming school year to Jennifer Christen, Student Success Coordinator.
- All current Marian students who are requesting accommodations should submit documentation to Jennifer Christen, Student Success Coordinator.
